Things very different second time around raced away at over ten an over. Waqas Hussein 52 and Ed Ballard 34 putting on 80 for the first wicket to set the foundation for setting Suffolk a testing target of 169 to win.

Three early wickets for Sam Rippington made early inroads and despite some lusty late hitting Cambridgeshire always held the upper hand getting by home by 27 runs.
